RESPONSIBILITY

Everyone in the castle is busy taking care of their responsibilities or using their talents/skills. List some of the jobs/responsibilities of people in the castle. Discuss the reasons why the princess might want to be busy too.

- What jobs does the princess take on by herself?
- What responsibility does the queen give the princess?
- What jobs could you do at home, at school, in your community?

CARING

The princess demonstrates care and understanding (empathy) for the people she meets outside the castle.

- What words does she use to show she cares?
- What acts of kindness does she perform for the people?
- What are some ways in which you could demonstrate kindness and empathy for friends, family members, classmates, people in your community?

CITIZENSHIP

Being a good citizen means doing your part to make the world a better place. It involves thinking about the common good, being a good neighbor, taking care of the environment, and following the rules of society.

- At the end of the story, how do both the King and Queen show good citizenship?
- How does the opening of The Café on the Moat make the kingdom a better place for all?
- What are some community service projects you, your classroom, school, family, or youth group could undertake to demonstrate good citizenship?
